


CHAINLINK FENCING

HISTORIC TREE BARRICADE REQUIRMENTS:

1. Existing historic trees to remain shall be protected during construction. Chain link fencing (Min. 6'-0" Height) shall be installed at a distance of 1 ½ times the dripline unless modifications have been approved by the City Forester. Tree barricade shall remain for the duration of construction. All other non-historic protected trees to remain shall be protected in accordance with the City's standards and ordinances.
2. Disposal of waste material, of any kind, shall not be allowed within the barricade area.
3. No attachments or wires of any kind, other than those of a protective nature, shall be attached to any historic tree.
4. No fill or excavation of any nature shall occur within the barricade area unless it has been approved by the City Forester.
5. No tools, equipment, or materials shall be stored within the barricade area.
6. Fencing shall be maintained and repaired as needed during construction.
7. All roots from historic trees beyond the barricade, that will be damaged during the construction process, shall be severed with a clean cut under the supervision of an ISA certified arborist.
