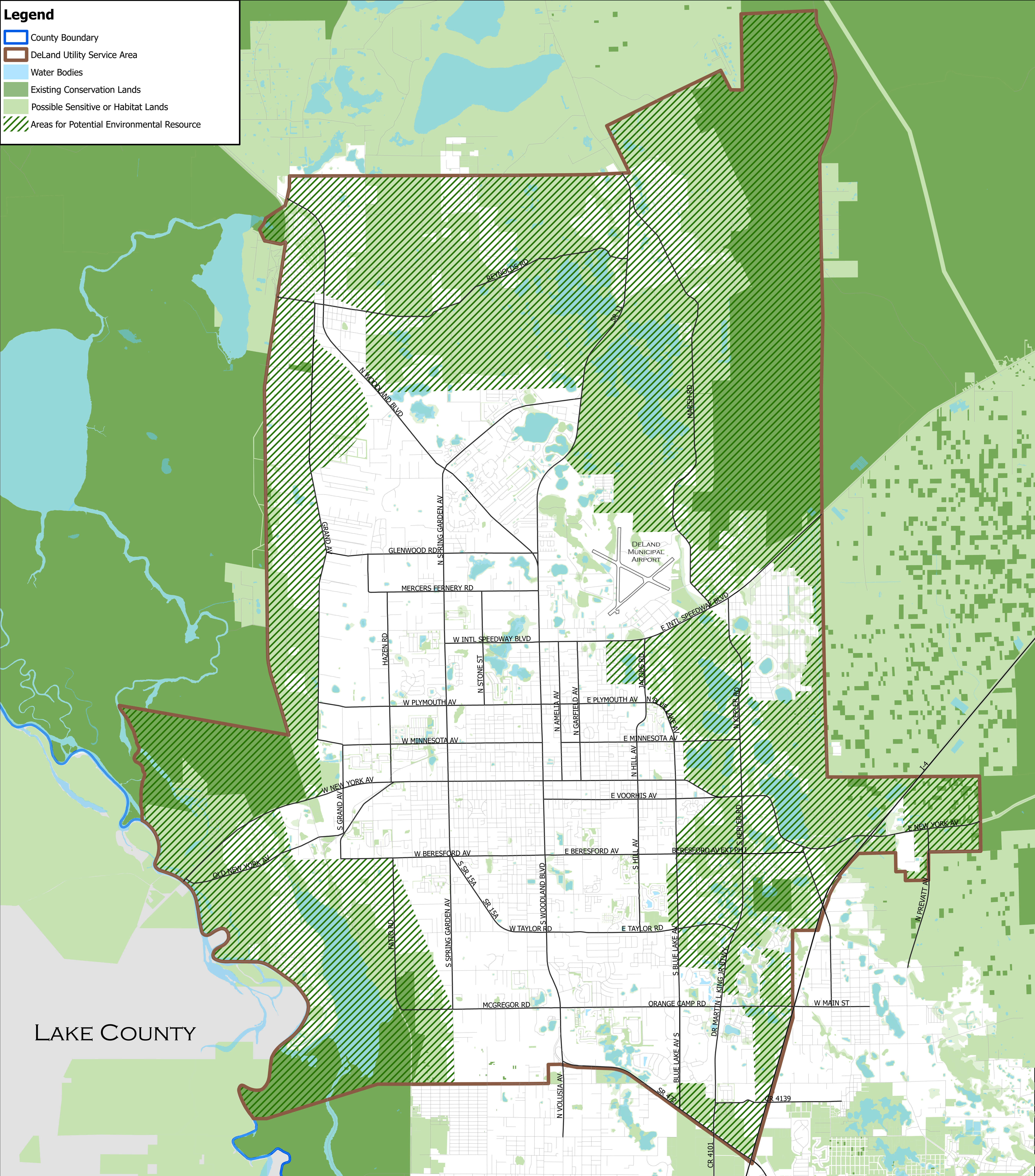

Generalized Areas of Environmental Resources DeLand Utility Service Area

Hatched areas on map based on the following factors:
(Not all listed sources may be reflected on this map.)

- Distance from urban core (preventing urban sprawl)
- Preservation of prime agriculture lands and open space
- Buffer to existing conservation areas
- 100-year floodplains: as designated on FEMA FIRM maps
- Areas requiring environmental review; as designated by the Volusia County Environmental Management Dept.
- National Wetlands Inventory for Volusia County (US Fish & Wildlife Service)
- Potential Scrub Jay habitat and sightings (Volusia County Environmental Management Dept.; data currently under review and may contain errors)
- Strategic Habitat Conservation Areas (FL Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission)
- Volusia County Future Land Use Map (in particular lands designated as: Conservation, Environmental Systems Corridor, Forestry Resource, and Agricultural Resource)
