



What would make you more likely to walk/bike to businesses or services in the City?








What aspect of Commercial Development is most appealing to you? (Select all that apply)

- Accessible by Transit (e.g., Votran/Uber/etc.) (17.69%)



As part of the 2050 Vision update, the City is also proposing revisions to the 2050 Vision Land Use Map.


For each category, indicate if you believe the areas should remain the same, increase, or decrease in size.
