

RESOLUTION 2016 - 60

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DeLAND, FLORIDA, CONFIRMING SUPPORT FOR AMENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SPRING HILL COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, on August 4, 2016 the Volusia County Council will consider whether to make a "Finding of Necessity" and declaring that the area lying within the proposed amended boundaries of the Spring Hill Community Redevelopment Area, as more particularly described in the attached Exhibit A, meet the definition of slum and blight, as defined by Section 163.335 Florida Statute, and will consider an ordinance amending the boundaries of the Spring Hill Community Redevelopment Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of DeLand by this resolution expresses its support of the County of Volusia's amendment of the Spring Hill Community Redevelopment Area boundaries.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF DELAND, FLORIDA:**

**Section 1.** That the City Commission of the City of DeLand does hereby support the Volusia County Council enacting an Ordinance to amend the Spring Hill Community Redevelopment Area boundaries, as more particularly depicted in the attached Exhibit A, to include within said boundaries additional area located within the corporate limits of the City of DeLand.



**Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.


